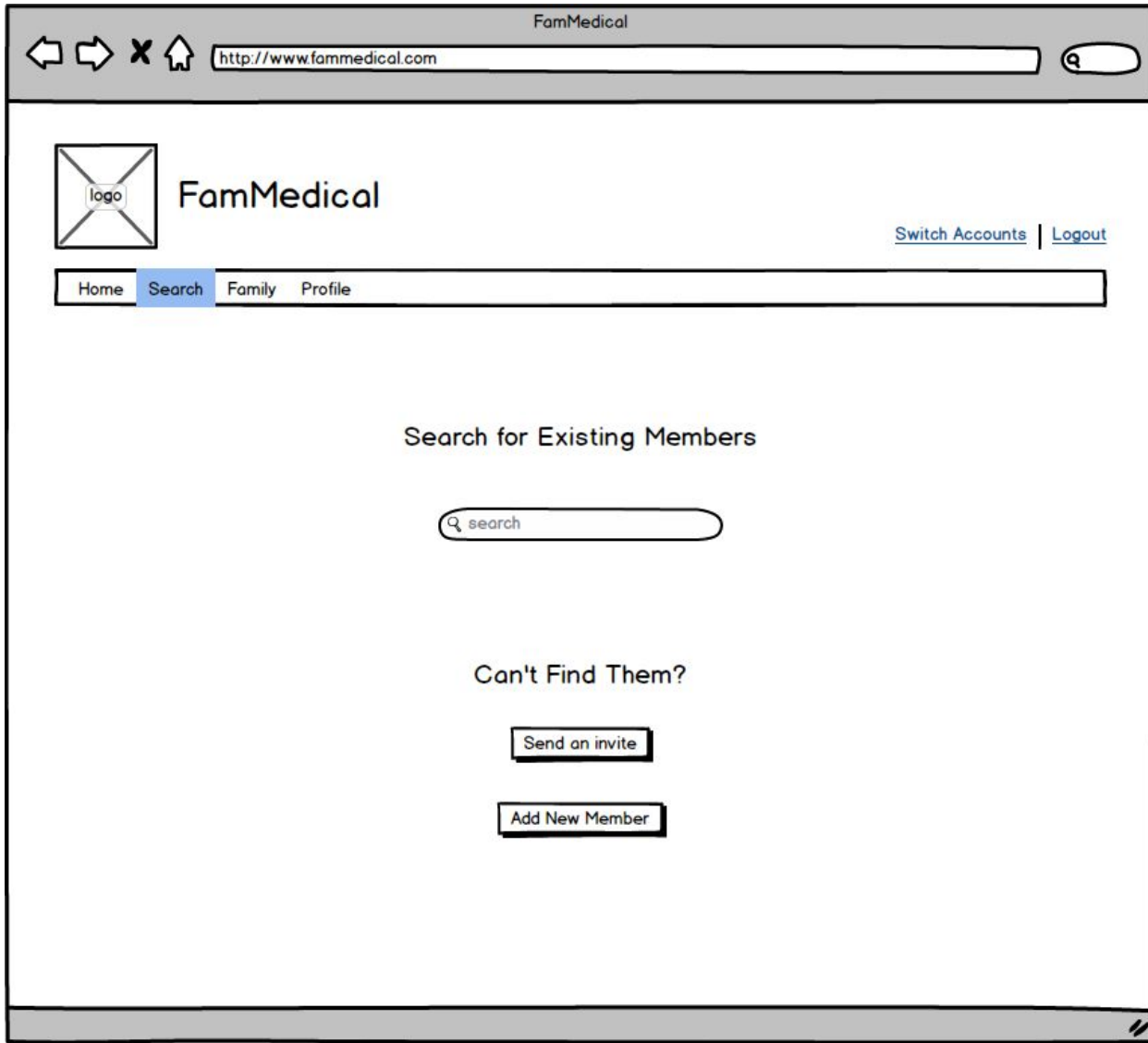


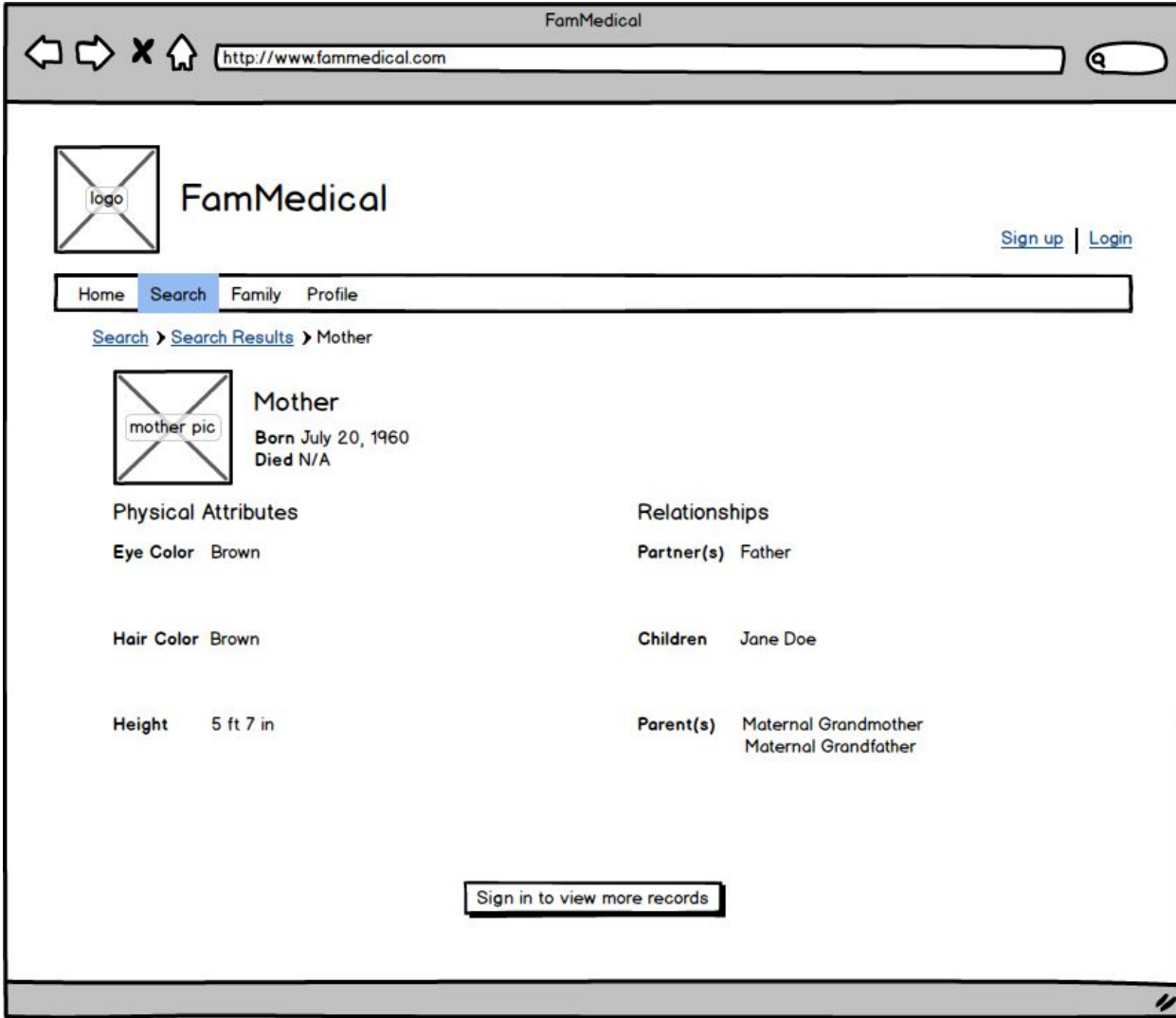
This is the home page where a user is signed in (the view would probably not differ for a signed out user except “Switch Accounts” would be “Sign Up” and “Logout” would be “Login”).

This page serves as an introduction with what they can do with this family history website.

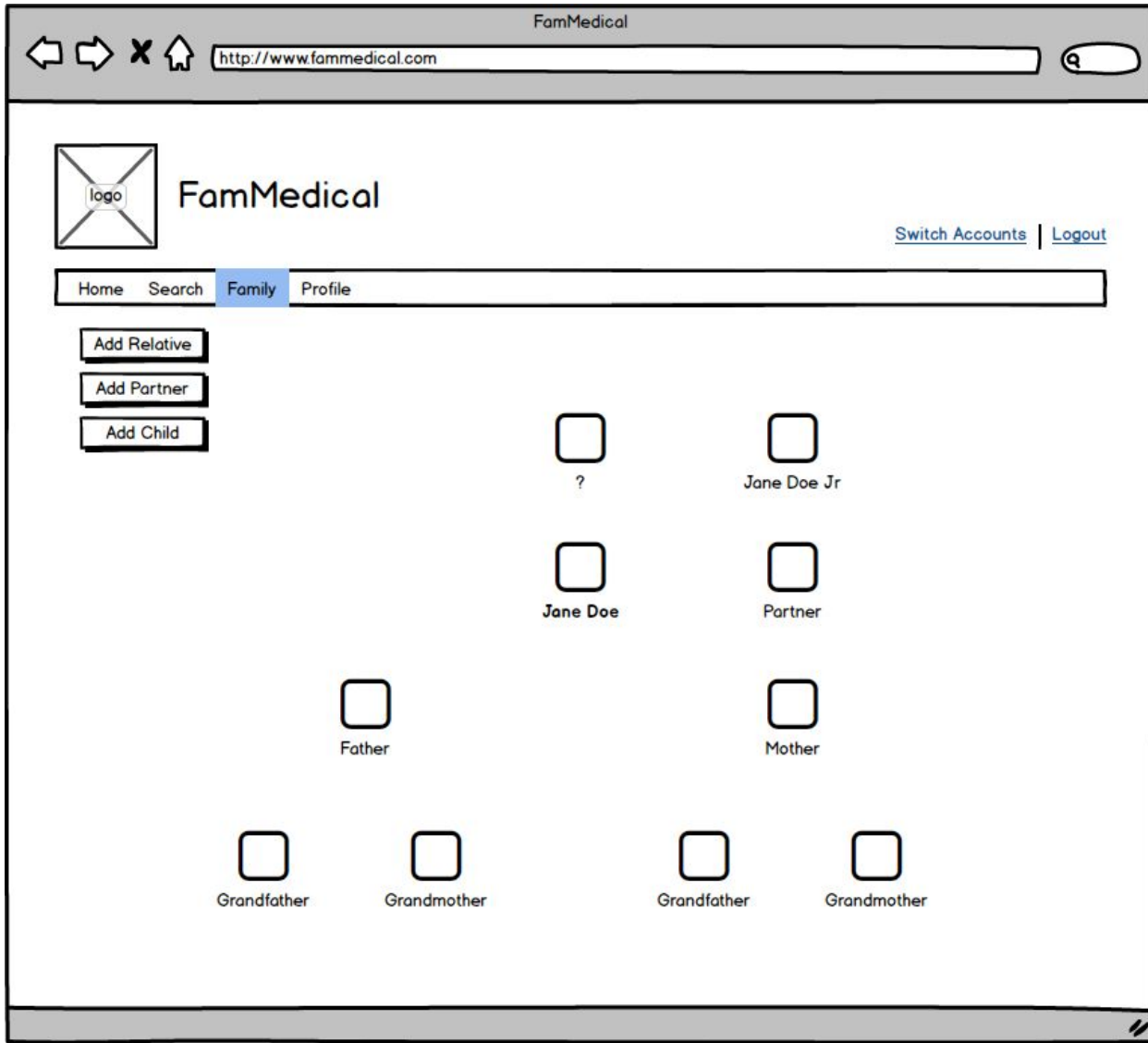
It encourages users to sign up.
